Fall 2020 Scholarship Program – Deadline extended to June 1, 2020

ASPE Educates and Mentors Professional Estimators for the sustainability of the construction industry, promotes the lifelong pursuit of excellence and credibility in professional estimating and develops a fellowship of professional estimators that connects and leads the construction industry.

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be currently enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited University or College with a Construction Science or Construction Management program and have a permanent/home address in the 15 County Kansas City Metropolitan Statistical Area (Missouri Counties: Jackson, Clay, Platte, Cass, Ray, Clinton, Bates, Lafayette, Caldwell - Kansas Counties: Wyandotte, Johnson, Leavenworth, Miami, Franklin, Linn).
- 2. Applicant must major or minor in a construction related field.
- 3. Applicant must be either a sophomore, junior or first semester senior.
- 4. Applicant must have a current cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher (based on a 4.0 scale).
- 5. Applicant shall have no relationship with any member of the Scholarship Committee or Board of Directors of ASPE Chapter 32.

Application Requirements:

The Applicant is responsible to provide the following information to the ASPE Scholarship Committee.

- 1. A Completed and Signed 2020 Scholarship Application Form. (Application Form is available by emailing your request to: aspechapter32@qmail.com with the following in the Email Subject Line: "Request for 2020 ASPE Chapter 32 Scholarship Application")
- 2. Official transcript of grades for the three (3) most recent semesters.
- 3. Listing of Extracurricular Activities
- 4. Employment History
- 5. Completed Essay

Evaluation Criteria:

- 1. Academic Performance (40%)
- 2. Extracurricular Activities (20%)
- 3. Essay (40%)
- 4. Additional information provided to the Committee, by the Applicant, for evaluation

Award:
